

The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe: Chapter 3-4 Activities

(Try having a go at one or two of the listed activities...)

Activity 1:

Write a conversation between Peter and Susan, in which they discuss Lucy's extraordinary story, and what it might mean. Remember that she is normally a 'very truthful girl,' and they would not expect her to be telling fibs!

Activity 2:

Draw and label a picture of the White Witch, based on how she is described when Edmund first meets her. Good pictures could form part of the Upper Elements competition display.

Activity 3:

The White Witch is clearly up to no good. When she gets home, she writes in her Witch Journal about her meeting with Edmund. Imagine what she might have to say... The entries which show the best sense of character or events will be given merits!

Activity 4:

Write a recipe for producing Turkish Delight, and explain why it is so good at making children happy.

Or, alternatively, write the recipe for a food which you find particularly tempting and explain why it's so!
